

Information on data privacy in accordance with Art. 13 of the General Data Privacy Regulation

Data processing in connection with event registrations of the KIT Graduate School "Enabling Net Zero" (ENZo) of the KIT Energy Center

With the following information, KIT provides you with an overview of data processing in the context of event registrations of the Graduate School "ENZo" and your data protection rights.

1. responsible persons

Responsible for data processing within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation (DS-GVO) and other data protection regulations is:

KIT is a public corporation. It is represented by the President Prof. Dr. Holger Hanselka. You can reach our data protection officer at dsb@kit.edu or at the postal address with the addition "Die Datenschutzbeauftragte".

2. method of data processing (incl. legal basis)

a. Scope: In the context of an event registration, your first and last name, as well as your e-mail address are processed (required mandatory information). In order to contact you in connection with the event (e.g. confirmation/cancellation of participation, notification in the event of changes to the general conditions - e.g. in the event of limited space allocation, with the possibility of subsequent admission to the event via a waiting list. In addition, we may use the e-mail address you have provided to send you event documents, also after the event. Only selected employees of the KIT Energy Center have access to your data.

b. Storage period: Your data will be stored as long as it is necessary for the above-mentioned purpose. This is usually the case two weeks after the event; under certain circumstances, the period may be longer if the purpose requires it. You have the right to revoke your consent to data processing at any time (for more information, see "c")

c. Legal basis and possibility of revocation: Your data will be processed based on your consent (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a). The granting of consent is voluntary. The consent can be revoked at any time with effect for the future. Effect for the future means that a revocation of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until the revocation. If consent is refused or revoked, no disadvantages will arise. To withdraw your consent, you can contact ENZo management (heike.kull@kit.edu).

3. your rights

You have the right to revoke your consent to the processing of your data in accordance with Article 7 (3) DS-GVO at any time with effect for the future. It can also refer to individual parts of the declaration.

Furthermore, you have the following rights with respect to us regarding your personal data:

- Right of confirmation whether data relating to you is being processed and information about the data processed, further information about the data processing and copies of the data (Article 15 DS-GVO).
- Right to have inaccurate or incomplete data corrected or completed (Article 16 DS-GVO).
- Right to erasure of data concerning you without delay (Article 17 DS-GVO)
- Right of restriction of processing (Article 18 DS-GVO).

You also have the right to complain to the supervisory authority about the processing of your personal data by the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) (Article 77 DS-GVO): the State Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information of Baden-Württemberg (<https://www.baden-wuerttemberg.datenschutz.de/>).
